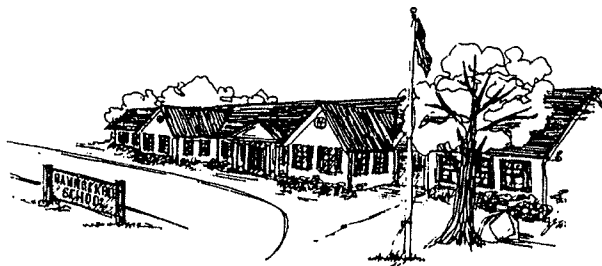

### **Re: Student Use of the District's Electronic Networks for 2010-11 School Year**

Dear Parents/Guardians:

We have the ability to enhance your child's education through the use of electronic networks, including the Internet. The Internet offers vast, diverse, and unique resources. Bannockburn School District's goal in providing this service is to promote educational excellence by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, and communication. Your authorization is needed before your child may use this resource.

The Internet electronically connects thousands of computers throughout the world and millions of individual subscribers. Students and teachers may have access to:

- Limited Electronic mail communications with people all over the world
- Information from government sources, research institutions, and other sources
- Discussion groups, and
- Many libraries, including the catalog to the Library of Congress, and the Educational Resources Information Clearinghouses (ERIC)

With this educational opportunity also comes responsibility. You and your child should read the enclosed **updated Rules and Regulation (6:235R)**, K-8 Guidelines (6:235R2), *Authorization and Agreement to Follow Rules for Technology Access (6:235A)* and discuss it together. The use of inappropriate material or language, or violation of copyright laws, may result in the loss of the privilege to use this resource. Remember that you are legally responsible for your child's actions.

The District takes precautions to prevent access to materials that may be defamatory, inaccurate, offensive, or otherwise inappropriate in the school setting. On an unregulated network, however, it is impossible to control all materials that may be defamatory, inaccurate, offensive, or otherwise inappropriate in the school setting. Ultimately parents/guardians are responsible for setting and conveying the standards that their child or ward should follow. To that end, the School District supports and respects each family's right to decide whether or not to authorize Internet access.

Please read and discuss the *Rules and Regulations* and *Authorization and Agreement to Follow Rules for Technology Access* with your child. If you agree to allow your child access, sign the two (2) Authorization forms (K-8 Guidelines (6:235R2), *Authorization and Agreement to Follow Rules for Technology Access (6:235A)*). Also included are the Authorization to Publish Student Work and/or image of Student on District Website (6:235C) and Authorization to Release student Images to Local Cable Television (6:235D) for your review and signature.
