Student Support Services

The district may provide the following student support services:

- a. The Superintendent or designee may implement procedures to further a healthy school environment and prevent or reduce the spread of disease, including head lice (*Pediculus Humanus Capitis*).
- b. Educational and psychological testing services and the services of a licensed psychologist as needed. If this is warranted, informed parental consent will be obtained in advance of any special testing.
- c. School-based counseling services delivered to students in need.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop protocols for responding to students with social, emotional, or mental health problems that impact learning ability. The District, however, assumes no liability for preventing, identifying, or treating such problems.

This policy shall be implemented in a manner consistent with State and federal laws, including the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004.
